Participants will be learning about strategy and risk, the Aged Care sector and Ethics (100% attendance required).

High profile guest speakers are invited to contribute at training sessions.

YESOD PROGRAM COMMITMENT

- Attendance at monthly Jewish Care Board Sub-Committee meetings to gain firsthand experience of governance structures and processes alongside witnessing the dynamics of board leadership on a not-for-profit board (80% attendance required).
- One-on-one mentoring with a Jewish Care Board Director.
- Participation in Chatham House sessions with applauded keynote speakers and interactive workshops with the wider not-for-profit sector (75% attendance required).
