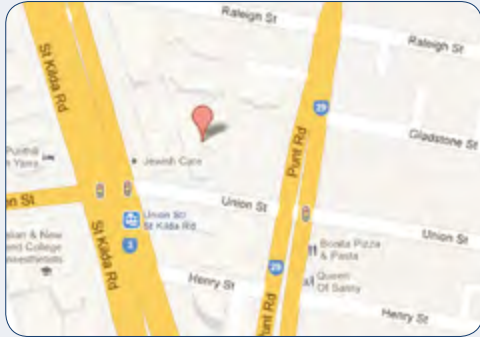


Location
